The Air Force has been designated as lead component for the renewable energy assessment and is using a Department of Defense renewable energy working group to conduct the assessment. The working group membership includes representatives from the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and the Department of Energy's Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, National Energy Renewable Laboratory, Sandia National Laboratory, and Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory. The scope and method of the assessment developed by the working group is enclosed.
